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Moving Forward Program (Parenting Orders Program)



This program has been designed to enable children's rights to feel secure, and to have an ongoing, loving relationship with both parents.

When separated parents are struggling with painful and complex issues, they can get stuck in conflict, which can go on for years. This may impact upon children's felt sense of security and well-being. The emotional, social and financial costs of continuing parental conflict can be overwhelming.

Children do best when their parents can stop looking back, and can start *moving forward*, away from the conflict and towards a more cooperative or business like relationship.



The Moving Forward (Parenting Orders) Program at the Sunshine Coast, is delivered by Foundations Child and Family Support Ltd.

FUNDING

The program receives funding from the Attorney-General's Department and is administered under the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs (FaHCSIA).

Our Consultants are professional staff qualified in the areas of psychology,

counseling, or social work.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Under the Family Law legislation, sessions with Consultants are confidential. What is discussed with the consultants cannot be used as evidence in Court.

Exceptions apply if criminal issues or intent are disclosed, or where there is risk of harm to an individual or others.

Many clients have Court Orders to utilise this program. Clients may be referred through another service provider or may self refer.

REGISTRATION
